

INTERNING AT FIRMS AND STARTUPS

- ▶ Trade-offs : Small vs. Mid-size vs. Large Corporations
- ▶ Working overtime is (arguably) better than no work!
- ▶ Lots of opportunities, but also lots of applicants for larger firms



Application guidelines? Keep at it.

WHY ARE YOU EVEN READING THIS PART ANYMORE ?

WHY GETTING PAID IS IMPORTANT (DOMESTIC INTERNSHIPS)

- ▶ Stipend = Value Attached to You = Work Expected of You
- ▶ Indicates how seriously an intern is taken at a company
- ▶ Proves you didn't just use "Pappa ke dost" to get in



IMHO though, if the work is interesting and the people are good, just do it for the experience

IIT, IAS, NIT INTERNSHIPS

- ▶ Summer and Winter Internship Programs set up at most IITs
- ▶ Email Professors at NITs, IISCs
- ▶ Indian Academies of Science (IAS) Scholarship awards Summer Internships from all the above institutes!

ADVANTAGES OF DOMESTIC INTERNSHIPS

- ▶ Easier to get into than internships abroad
- ▶ Expenditure is not much even if it is unpaid
- ▶ Continued Collaboration
- ▶ Build a professional network

INTERNATIONAL INTERNSHIP PROGRAMS


- ▶ Opportunities open across the globe
- ▶ Generally sponsored, and well-planned
- ▶ Needs a proven track record of skills
- ▶ Application process is long and intensive



TLDR; such effort, (but) much amaze

WRITING TO PROFESSORS DIRECTLY

- ▶ You need to have a great profile for consideration
- ▶ Emails need to be succinct, eloquent
- ▶ Usually 1-5 percent response rate
- ▶ Patience is key





HOW TO GET STARTED?


- ▶ Find information about the places you wish to apply to

- ▶ Find a Program listing online
- ▶ Determine your Eligibility criteria
- ▶ Prepare your essays, CV
- ▶ Verify all application details REPEATEDLY

- ▶ Explain past experience and relevant projects



ESSAY WRITING


- ▶ Motivation to Apply

- ▶ Cover Letter
- ▶ Resume/CV

BREAKPOINTS - I


- ▶ DO NOT BLUFF
- ▶ Typographical Errors
- ▶ Falsified Data
- ▶ Prioritise important information
- ▶ Grammatical Errors

BREAKPOINTS – II

- ▶ Essays must be well researched
- ▶ Verify application details repeatedly!
- ▶ Details of past experiences should be provided
- ▶ LinkedIn Profile
